Choosing the right image: Think laterally. Think fun. Think real.

Images aren't an afterthought, they're the first impression that a reader will have. For best results please provide ArtsHub with a choice of images that reflect our readers passion; make sure they are full of colour, life, art and performance. Please see opposite for examples of the type of images that will get you the best result:

- **Please note:** *We will use discretion when publishing your featured article image.*
- Images that lack artistic merit, may not be accepted, and we will ask for an alternative image.
- We cannot use a portrait aspect image for the featured image and this **MUST be a landscape** image.
- Images containing logos, such as images with overlaid text, banner media will also **not be accepted** as per our branding policy.

Image Specification checklist:

1. **No overlaid text or logos**
2. 900 x 556 px or ratio 16:10 (**landscape required**)
3. .jpeg .jpg or .gif are accepted formats
4. Max file size: 5MB
5. Recommended colour: sRGB at 72 dpi or 150 dpi

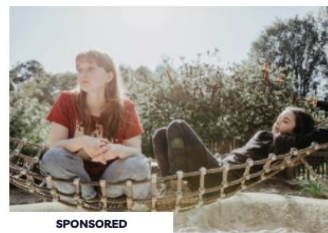
